For

FENCE INSTALLATION/CONSTRUCTION

- A FENCE DRAWING GUIDELINE is attached for your use in preparing your application.
- Attach a copy of your existing site plan/plat/survey indicating the location of the proposed fence and gates.
- Attach a drawing, photo, or brochure of the proposed fence designs, including dimensions, color, and materials to be used.
- Prior to any digging or excavating, please contact Sunshine 811 for subsurface utility designation.
- Fences must follow in close proximity of, but not encroach across the property line.
- No fence or wall shall be permitted to extend forward toward the front of the lot farther than the midpoint of dwelling (see FENCE DRAWING GUIDE).
- The unfinished side of the fence (showing the posts and other supporting members) must face the interior of the lot on which the fence is built.
- No fence over six feet (6') in height shall be permitted on any lot.
- Fences must be of new material and constructed of brick, stucco, finished masonry, black aluminum picket or poly vinyl chloride (PVC). PVC is the preferred material; due to longevity and ease of maintenance.
- Gates are to consist of compatible materials and style.
- All fences must be maintained in accordance with the Maintenance requirements as outlined on page 7 of the Rules, Guidelines & Standards.
